REGISTRATION CONFIRMATION NOTIFICATION OF CHANGES

After completing the online registration, you will have received a registration confirmation by email. If necessary, please also check your spam folder. The email also contains a change link. This means that changes (e.g. address data) can be made later. Please check your data. Immediately after the registration deadline on March 24th, 2024, you will receive another email with a summary of the registration data, the start number and a change link.

CHANGES / TRANSFER OF START NUMBER

After registration deadline on March 24th, 2024, transferring the starting place is <u>only possible digitally via the change link</u> provided (see above) for a fee (\in 5). Changes to registration are only possible digitally via the change link for a fee (\in 5). Possible payment methods are SEPA direct debit and Paypal. We ask for your attention!

If you have any questions, our service team will be happy to help you in the registration tent.

STARTING NUMBERS

Starting numbers will be handed out in the <u>registra-</u> tion tent at the start and finish area by showing your registration confirmation which comes via email right after registration.

LUGGAGE STORAGE

A small piece of luggage can be stored in the registration tent. It must be collected before 4:30 pm again. However, the organizers will not accept any responsibility for lost or stolen goods. **Please note that the organizer assumes no liability for lost or lost items.**

SHUTTLE-BUS / PARKING

The number of parking spaces is limited so we would strongly advise you to use the free <u>shuttle-bus service</u>. This service will be running on raceday from 7:30 am to 5:30 pm at the <u>pick-up points</u>.

TIME MEASUREMENT

A transponder on the start number measures the time. The start number must be clearly visible on the chest and must not be folded.

In the duo marathon, the starting runner receives a start number band with the start number including a transponder for timing purposes. This must be passed on to the partner runner in the transition area in Bad Dürkheim.

The running routes were remeasured. There were some optimizations in the route, especially in the half marathon. Please familiarize yourself with the <u>running route in advance</u>.



The running routes are marked by directional signs. In addition, every kilometer is marked. The marathon/half marathon points in Kleinkarlbach are marked. Intermediate times in the half marathon at km 10, in the marathon at the half distance and in the duo marathon just before the transition zone.

DUO-MARATHON

A special train (departure 9.58 am) transports the runners from the railway station Bockenheim to Bad Dürkheim. The start number is the ticket. The change zone for <u>duo-marathon</u> is at the refreshment point at km 20. The return from the railway station Bad Dürkheim will be at 12:10 am, and 1:10 pm. Further information see here.

NOODLE PARTY

The noodle party takes place on Saturday from 3:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. in the festival tent.

A voucher for this is included with the start number.



REFRESHMENT

There are eleven refreshment points along the route at km 5.5 / 9.5 / 13.5 / 20 / 23 / 27.5 / 31 / 33 / 37 / 39 and at the finish.

Here you will receive (subject to change!):

- Peterstaler water medium
- Peterstaler water Black Forest- silent
- Peterstaler apple spritzer and Peterstaler top fit (with magnesium)
- Tea / fruit / Peterstaler Cola mix (Km 33)

In addition, there are three water points along the route at km 3, km 15.5 and km 29. Only Peterstaler Black Forest is offered here. Please use the waste containers for drinking cups. Palatinate wine is also available at all refreshment points.

Your own food must be handed in at the information stand in the marquee by 8:30 a.m. on Sunday at the latest, complete with the start number and details of the refreshment point. This is provided on an external table. With the starting documents, all athletes will receive a grape-shaped sponge for refreshment at the food and water points. END OF OFFICIAL TIMING

Half-marathon (1:00 pm), marathon and duo-marathon (3:30 pm). The racecourse can only be closed to traffic for a limited amount of time.

Therefore, we reserve the right to stop and exclude runners who pass the refreshment area V3 at Weisenheim am Berg after 11.50 am.

The same rules are applied to:

- km 20 (Bad Dürkheim, V4 the latest 12:45 pm)
- km 27 (Kallstadt, V6 the latest 1:40 pm)
- km 31 (Dackenheim, V7 The latest 2:10 pm)
- km 33 (Kirchheim, V8 the latest 2:25 pm)
- km 37 (Grünstadt, V9 the latest 2:55 pm)

When emergency vehicles approach, runners must run as far to the right as possible, regardless of the section of the route, in order to give the BOS vehicles clear travel.

RESULTS

Result lists are not printed and are therefore not published on site. All athletes can view their personal running results at terminals on the festival site. By scanning the start number, the data can be read out in the system.

AWARD CEREMONY

The awards take place in the festival tent. For the half marathon at 1:00 p.m. and for the marathon and duo marathon at 3:30 p.m. To be honored:

- Overall winner women/men (places 1 to 3)
- Duo marathon (places 1 to 3)
- best Palatinate runner
- Best runner in the Bad Dürkheim district

For foreign winners, statutory tax will be deducted when the prize money is paid out and paid directly to the tax office. Domestic winners must declare their income to the tax office themselves.

The winners (1st to 3rd place) of all age groups receive wine gifts and can receive them from 2:00 p.m. (half marathon) or 4:00 p.m. (marathon) - upon presentation of the start number - at the i-point at the marquee entrance.

It is not possible to ship the non-cash prizes.

HEALTH / MASSAGE

Medical staff from the DRK German Red Cross) will be present at each refreshment point and at the finish area. Participants must immediately stop competing when ordered to do so by the doc- tor in charge or an offical member of the medical team (DRK). Furthermore, short massages will be offered in a tent near the finish area.

DISQUALIFICATION

Unsportsmanlike and undisciplined behavior, in particular hindering other participants and unauthorized outside help (e.g. pacemaker on a bicycle) or leaving the route will lead to disqualification.

TOILETS

Toilets are located on the festival site in <u>the start and</u> <u>finish area and in the changing rooms</u>. In addition, there are mobile toilets on the running route in the immediate vicinity of the refreshment points.

RETURN OPPORTUNITY

From the refreshment points, runners who are unable to finish the race will be brought back to Bockenheim by collective transport by the DRK.
